Cameras With Built-In Web Servers Allow Remote Monitoring Of Homes Or Businesses Via Internet

Panasonic presents the new BB-HCM381A Network Camera that allows users to monitor remote locations from nearly anywhere in the world via the Internet.¹

Available through USA PhoneCenters, Cherry Hill NJ for professional installation, the new model offers high-quality, 640 x 480, live video at up to 12 frames per second or 320 x 240 video at 30 frames per second. This permits crystal-clear remote viewing via a network or the Internet from nearly any Internet-enabled device, including a PC, PDA or on a compatible cell phone². In addition, the camera comes equipped with an SD Memory Card slot for easy image recording.

"This new Panasonic Certified network camera gives the ability to not only view a remote location, but also communicate with people in that location via the camera's two-way audio feature," says Greg Gutos, General Manager, USA PhoneCenters "It's perfect for anyone who wants to easily monitor their home or business, no matter where they are in the world."

The compact camera can easily be placed where there is an Ethernet (10/100 BaseT Switch) connection. Images are automatically uploaded to the camera's built-in Web page for viewing from virtually any location. For easy access to the camera's video, special software embedded in all Panasonic network cameras creates a personal, permanent Web address on the free Viewnetcam.com service. Up to 30 users can view images simultaneously, and access to the camera can be password-protected with different access privileges. Control software and e-mail software (SMTP) are included.

For added utility, the Cameras can be connected to two optional security devices, such as a motion sensor or smoke detector, and can be programmed to e-mail an alert when the alarm has been triggered. The camera can also be connected to a relay and door opener to grant access to authorized people via remote control.

They are IPv6-ready for added security. Other camera features include image date and time stamping, image recording onto an SD Memory Card with the built-in SD Memory Card slot, as well as recording via Panasonic's new BB-HNP11A recording software, high-speed 100-degree-per-second pan-and-tilt control, a two-way audio feature and the ability to capture live video in low-light situations (down to 3 Lux or an incredible 0.1 Lux when in Color Night View Mode)
